<div><div>BURNABLE TRASH</div><div>Every <div></div> and <div></div></div></div>	<div>raw food(food scraps,leftovers,garbage) plastic wraps rubber goods non-recyclable paper and cloths twings leather goods(shoes,bags) diapers other burnable trash small enough to be placed in designated bags</div> <div></div> <div><ul style="list-style-type: none">● Put trash into designated collection bags before dumping.● Try to make compost from food scraps. Make sure to drain off water from the refuse.● Twigs and wood chips should be cut into size of shorter than 60 cm and placed in the designated bag before dumping.● A large volume of burnable trash should be individually taken to the Sanitation Center.● Flush excrement in the toilet.</div>	
<div><div>RECYCABLE TRASH</div><div>landfill trash special trash</div><div>Every <div></div> and <div></div></div><div>Collection days may be changed in some areas for year-end and New Year holidays.Check the collection service calendar for your local collection days.</div><div>All trash should be smaller than a size of 18L can ,so dump bigger trash on the collection day for large-size refuse.</div><div>Work with your neighborhood for collecting recyclables</div><div>Cooperate with your community for a group collection of precious recyclables, including newspapers,magazines, cardboards,cloths and fabrics, beer bottles.Child volunteers, P.T.A.,and neighborhood association will be at your service.</div><div></div></div>	<div>CANS</div> <div>aluminum cans(pop-top) steel cans (pop-top)</div> <div></div> <div><ul style="list-style-type: none">● Rinse cans with water before dumping.● Spray cans may explobe,so make sure to pierce holes in them before dumping.</div>	
	<div>BOTTLES</div> <div>bottles (1.8L bottles,beer bottles) other bottles(colorless,brown, blue-green,black)</div> <div></div> <div><ul style="list-style-type: none">● Rinse bottles with water before dumping.● Remove caps from the bottles to include them in the group of metals,hard plastics, or other unsortables.● Separate beer bottles from 1.8L bottles.● Other bottles should be separated into four groups of colors.</div>	
	<div>PLASTICS</div> <div>styrofoam trays styrofoarm PET bottles hard plastics</div> <div></div> <div><ul style="list-style-type: none">● Rinse plastics with water before dumping.● Remove any attached caps to include them in the group of hard plastics,● Bring Styrofoam trays and PET bottles to supermarkets to cooperate with their recycling.</div>	
	<div>METALS AND OTHER UNSORTABLE TRASH</div> <div>pots and pans steel scraps kettles umbrellas tinplates appliances and other small-size electrical equipment</div> <div></div> <div><ul style="list-style-type: none">● This particular group for disposal includes trash which cannot be properly separated, such as trash with metals,plastics,glass, wood,cloths,etc mixed together.</div>	
	<div>PAPERS</div> <div>newspapers cartons inserted bills other recyclable papers magazines corrugated cardboards</div> <div></div> <div><ul style="list-style-type: none">● Bind together respective grouped papers crosswise before dumping them.It is recommended to use a paper string instead of a vinyl string for binding.● Rinse the cartons with water and flatten them to be tied up for dumping. Cartons having silver coating inside should be included in the group of burnable trash.● No collection service on rainy days.</div>	
	<div>CLOTHS AND FABRICS</div> <div>clothes rags</div> <div></div> <div><ul style="list-style-type: none">● Bind together cloths and fabrics crosswise with a string before dumping them.● Clothes soiled with oil and the like cannot be recycled, so include them in the group of burnable trash.● No collection service on rainy days.</div>	
	<div>LANDFILL TRASH</div> <div>ceramic ware glass brics and concrete debris and the like bottles for cosmetics use (ceramic or glass)</div> <div></div> <div><ul style="list-style-type: none">● Break down landfill trash into the size of a fist. A large amount of this sort of trash should be taken to the final treatment site after obtaining a permission for disposal at the city environment section and measuring the weight at the Clean Center. For more information, call the city environment section.</div>	
	<div>SPECIAL TRASH</div> <div>dry batteries thermometers and othere quipment containing mercury</div> <div></div> <div><ul style="list-style-type: none">● Take TV sets, refrigerators,washing machines,or air conditioners to the store where you bought them or to the store you will make a new purchase.(Charged)● Separation of the trash will be instructed at the site of disposal.● Mattresses with built-in springs are accepted if disassembled.● Each collection site is open from 6:30 to 8:30 AM for disposal. No disposal should be made at other hours.</div>	

LARGE-SIZE REFUSE

Every Wednesday

The schedule of collection service may de changed in some areas for New Year holidays, so check your collection service calendar.

◎Never take trash out the night before!
◎Be sure to take trash out by 8:30 AM on the pick up day!

The Clean Center and city sanitation authority dose not handle the following waste.

Industrial waste,non-separated trash,propane gas tanks, batteries,cans containing oil or paint,fire extinguishers, poison,agricheical,agricultural machinery,motorcycles, construction waste material,TV sets, washing machines, drying machines, air conditioners, refrigerators,tires,etc.

The following waste should be brought directly to the Clean Center Kinuura or handled by a licensed non-industrial waste processor.

A large amount of trash unexpectedly disposed of in a family matter,such as moving, memorial service, gardening,mowing and the like. Business-related trash dumped by companies, stores,restaurants,etc.

Bring in the Clean Center will be a fee.

Amount of waste
Less than 100 kg : free
More than 100 kg : 50 yen per 10 kg

1. Put your trash out at the designated collection site.
2. Put your trash out on the designated day at the appointed time.
3. Separate trash into separate places.
